



## PotashCorp Scholarship Guidelines

These scholarships are generously provided from a fund created by Potash Corporation of Saskatchewan for graduating students of the Sussex Area. The following conditions and regulations will be considered in selecting the recipients of this award. In 2018, there will be five (5) PotashCorp Scholarships awarded at a value of \$2500 each. These scholarships are administered by Sussex Area Community Foundation.

**The PotashCorp Scholarship Applicant must be a current graduating student of Sussex Regional High School, Belleisle Regional High School, Cambridge-Narrows Community School or Sussex Christian School who:**

- a) **Demonstrates financial need.**
- b) **Shows academic achievement.**
- c) **Exhibits community involvement.**
- d) **Will be attending an accredited post-secondary institution in New Brunswick in the fall of 2018.**

**Priority will be given to students:**

- . who may not otherwise be able to continue their education due to financial considerations

**You must include the following information with your application:**

1. Acceptance letter or conditional acceptance letter from a post – secondary institution
2. Copy of your Spring transcript with Grade 11 & 12 marks. (A transcript with all grade 11 and all first semester final and midterm grade 12 marks.) **Applications cannot be processed in the absence of this transcript.**
3. A letter(s) of recommendation.
4. Any supporting documentation necessary.

It is the responsibility of the Applicant to meet all deadlines. The Application deadline is **May 18, 2018 at 12pm**. Mail your application along with your **Spring Transcript and all other pertinent information** to the address on the Application Form or drop off at 490 Main Street, Sussex, NB, E4E 2S4.

The recipients will be announced at your school's **Graduation Exercises** in June 2018.
